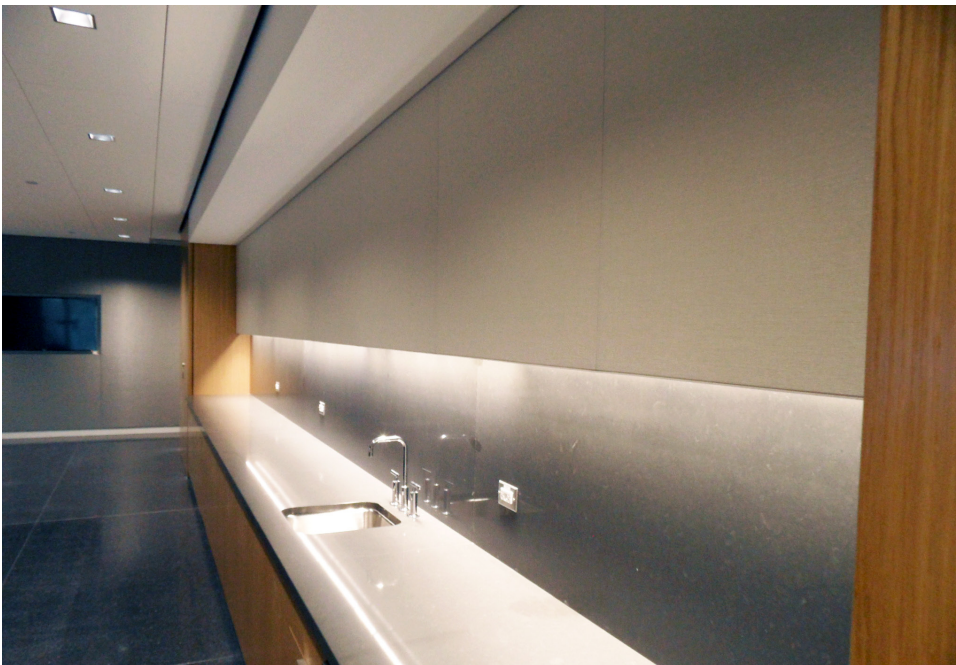
Xorel Meteor for Panels



Xorel was selected for the new sports pavilion and the McCormick Education Center at Northwestern University in Chicago because the designers at Perkins + Will needed a light colored performance textile to cover acoustic panels in high traffic areas of the school. Pattern Meteor is installed in classrooms, hallways and dance studios.
